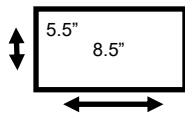
Tulare County Agriculture... Generations of Growing Goodness

- Entries must be original hand drawn artwork.
- Do not include any signatures on front of artwork.
- No computer generated art. Must be scannable for printing.
- Only the theme words may appear in art, please check spelling!
- No political statements, or negative imagery about agriculture.
- A legible entry form (below) must be on back of all artwork.



(Please tape form on back side of art, no staples).

Entries will be judged on:

Ag Content 50%—Originality 20%—Reproducibility 20%—Neatness 10%
